Daisy (seen on the cover of this brochure) was the beloved Yorkie of Ami Gordon, founder of DaisyCares. The summer of Daisy's fourth year of life, she suddenly became ill over the course of several months, eventually leading to uncontrollable grand mal seizures. Daisy was taken to A&M's College of Veterinary Medicine in College Station for treatment. Once there, Daisy's condition quickly worsened and she fell into a coma with virtually no hope of survival. On the 6th day of Daisy's coma, which was already several days after it looked like there was no hope, she began to blink her eye. The next day Daisy moved her tongue; the following day she cocked her head; and within days she was walking and going home. Daisy was able to live many more years until passing away at 12 years of age. Her family wants to share her second chance of life with others.

DaisyCares aspires to a world where pets are given hope: hope for food, hope for care, hope for love, and hope for life. Daisy inspired Ami to set up a program to help pet owners in need. Veterinary Care Program

Project Kindness

Project Kindness provides year round education free of charge to children ages PreK3 to high school. This program creates awareness and encourages empathy and respect for all animals. Content is based on the age group, class size, and time available.

Daisy's Barn

Established in 2017, Daisy's Barn is the newest addition to programs. This barn houses sheep, goats, and chickens and serves as a hands-on component to Project Kindness.
